



The Stouffville Lawn Bowling Club, incorporated in 1894, is located at 4 Church Street South, just south of Main Street at the clock tower, about a 15 minute drive from the Ballantrae back gate.

Lawn bowling is a popular game across the world and suitable for participants of all ages.

The object of the game is to roll a ball, or bowl, closest to the target ball, a small white ball called a jack. The bowl's design, slightly flattened on one side, creates the challenge of the game.

The shape of the bowl causes it to travel on a curved path, or bias.

We play in teams of fours, triples or pairs and singles. And we're set up to offer a good season (May to October) of both recreational and competitive games. Most of our club bowling is done in the beautiful summer evenings—playing in leagues where we're teamed up ahead of time to play in a series of about 10 weekly games.

We have snacks at the end of every game, giving us a chance to socialize and create friendships. Four times during the summer we have Bowl and Dine nights where we combine dinner at the clubhouse with fun bowling games.

Going to be away for a while? No problem. We have substitutes to fill in for you.
