They are currently in the parking lot at the shelter being fed and cared for at Dominion Church International located at 2256 Sheppard Avenue West in North York - 647-848-1962. They are desperately in need of clean gently used or new winter wear (coats, hats, scarves, gloves and blankets). Tim Horton or any other gift cards would also be appreciated.

If you find it in your heart to help, you may drop off at the above location or message me for a pickup of clothes and gift cards.

If you are located in Ajax, Pickering, Scarborough, Markham or North York, my granddaughter's Tyfanny-Rose and Yvonne Stanley, along with my daughter Judy Stanley (416-388-8485) will coordinate and be happy to pick up anything that you wish to donate. Please ensure the items are in clear bags.
